God becomes All in all. (1 Corinthians 15:20-28)

<b>Who is acting as God's instrument?</b>	Body of Christ serves as God's instrument (Ambassadors) as God interacts with mankind. (Christ is completing God becoming All in all, with the Body acting as Christ's complement -- Ephesians 1:22-23)	Believing Israel serves as God's instrument as God interacts with mankind.		
<b>Who is the ekklesia (called-out-ones ... commonly translated "church")?</b>	The ekklesia = The Body of Christ (Israel is calloused "until the complement of the nations may be entering. And thus all Israel shall be saved..." -- Rom 11:25-26)	The ekklesia = Believing Israel (The Bride of Christ)

<b>How does God reveal His plans?</b>	Only to Paul does God reveal the "snatching away" of the Body.	To John God revealed the events to take place in the "Lord's Day" (Revelation 1:10)	To John God revealed Christ's return to the earth to reign	Only to Paul does God reveal the "consummation" to occur at the completion of the eons. [Note: There is a purpose to the eons -- Ephesians 3:11]
